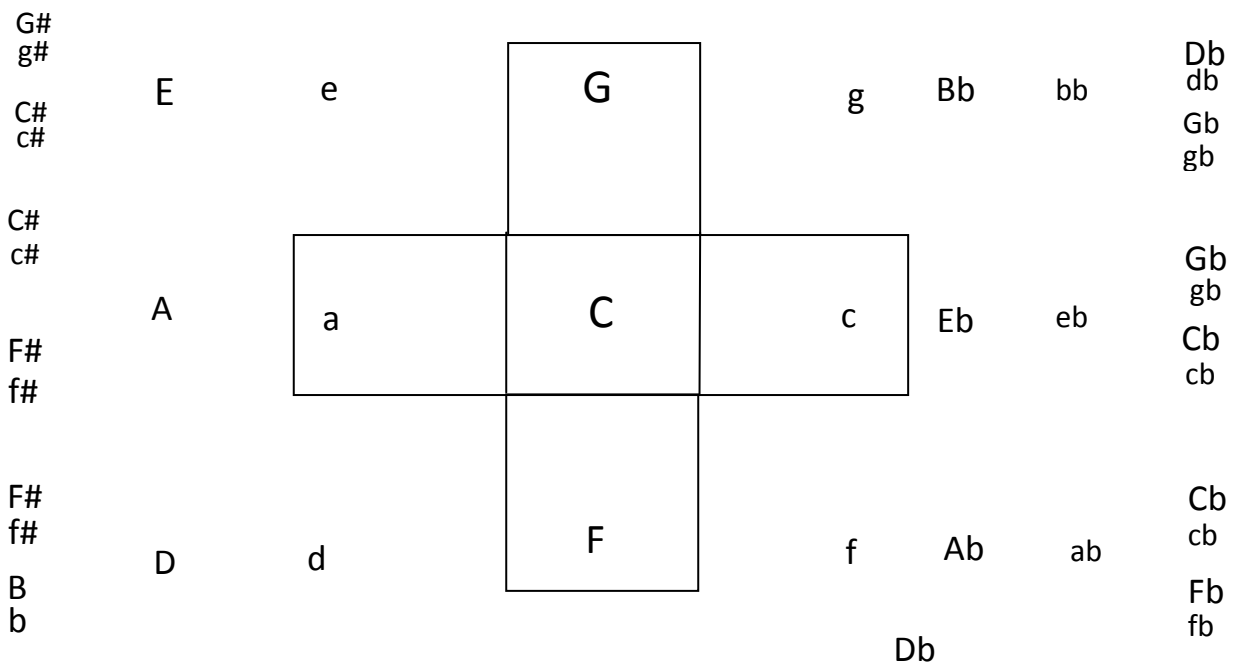
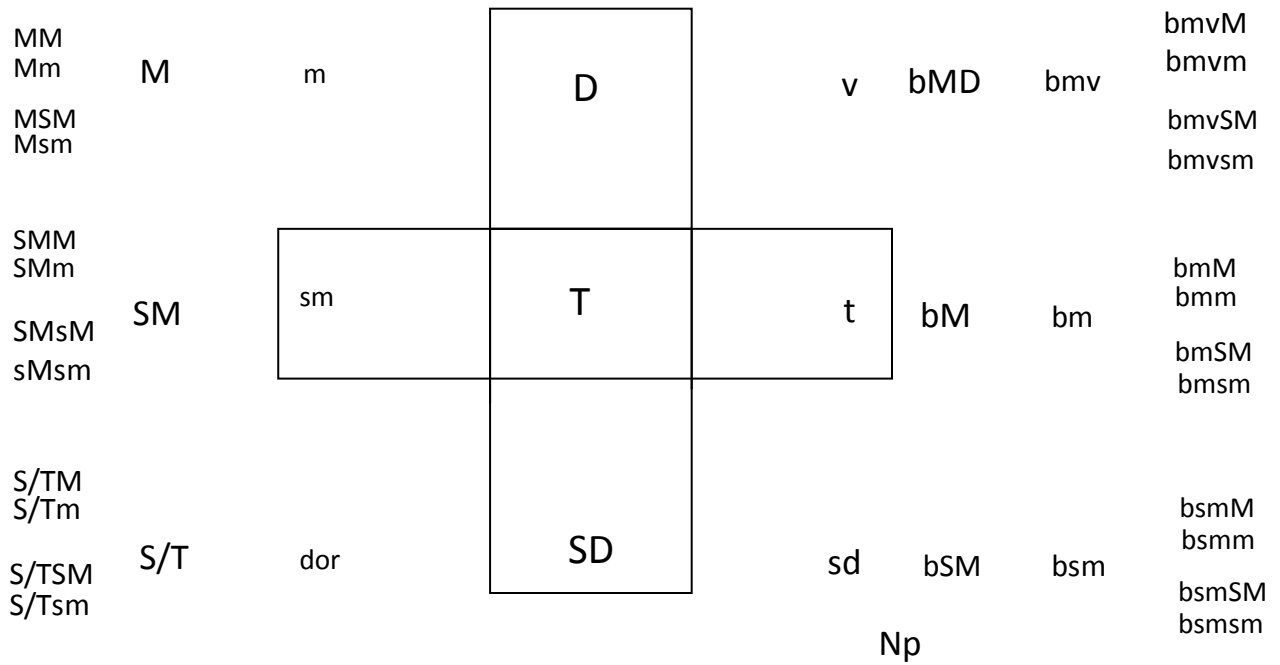


Map of Tonal Regions
